#### Low Season (7 Feb - 20 Dec)

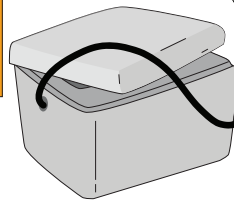

### POLYSTYRENE

All clean polystyrene excluding meat trays.



### SOFT PLASTICS

Clean soft plastics like bread bags, chippie wrappers, produce bags and frozen veggie bags are collected and sent to Future Post in Waiuku where they're made into fence posts.

### BREAD TAGS & PLASTIC LIDS

Collect bread tags and plastic lids (separate from soft plastics) and drop to Anamata. These are sent to Future Post where they're made into fencing products.

**South - Monday Collection:** Areas South of the 'Crossroads' (intersection of Blind Bay, Hector Sanderson and Gray Roads) including Claris. **North - Tuesday Collection:** Including Okupu, Whangaparapara and Northern areas.
